Action research is a method for improving and modifying the working environment of any organization or any specific activity. In any school setting the teachers, administrators, parents and other related authorities are keen to bring desirable modifications in the current practices. The teachers and the principal are able to study their problems scientifically and therefore with their personal involvement they may find out proper solutions of their problems. It is an **objective-oriented** method to find out practical solutions of the problems any teacher or principal is facing in his daily job-activities the action research improves and modifies the current practices of a teacher and administrator.

In fact action research has added altogether new dimensions in the field of research. Traditionally, it was believed that educational research is the monopoly of genius or trained research experts but with the advent of action research each and every practitioner-teachers, administrators and others may carry out research work in to improve their own work, behaviour and the related work climate.

Objectives of the workshop

- To enable teachers become competent in innovatively used action research to supplement their teaching methods and thereby achieve enhanced student learning;

- To enhance problem solving attitude among teachers and principals for studying the problems of students.
- To provide an overview and understanding of action research and its application in real classroom setting.
- To give an insight on a series of problems faced by teachers during teaching learning process.
- To improve participants' awareness of the potential of action research to enhance teaching and learning across the curriculum.

Training Methods

The training cum workshop will be carried out using a number of methods that were combined.

- **Peer based training:** This will ensure that teachers are trained for the context of their workplace. The participants will have varied group activities to gain the key fundamentals and principles of action research integration in the curriculum. The hand on experiences will be given to the teachers in this workshop.
- **Experts and Resource person's presentation:** The participants will be exposed to the expertise of the renowned resource persons associated with Action research work in the School curriculum. This will enable to the participants learn best practices from the experts teachers who are using Action research in the classroom.
- **Experience sharing:** Some specific sessions of the workshop will be used to have the participants share their best experiences in regards to challenges and barriers to successful practices of action research in the teaching and learning environment.
