



Research Methodology Workshop using R Software

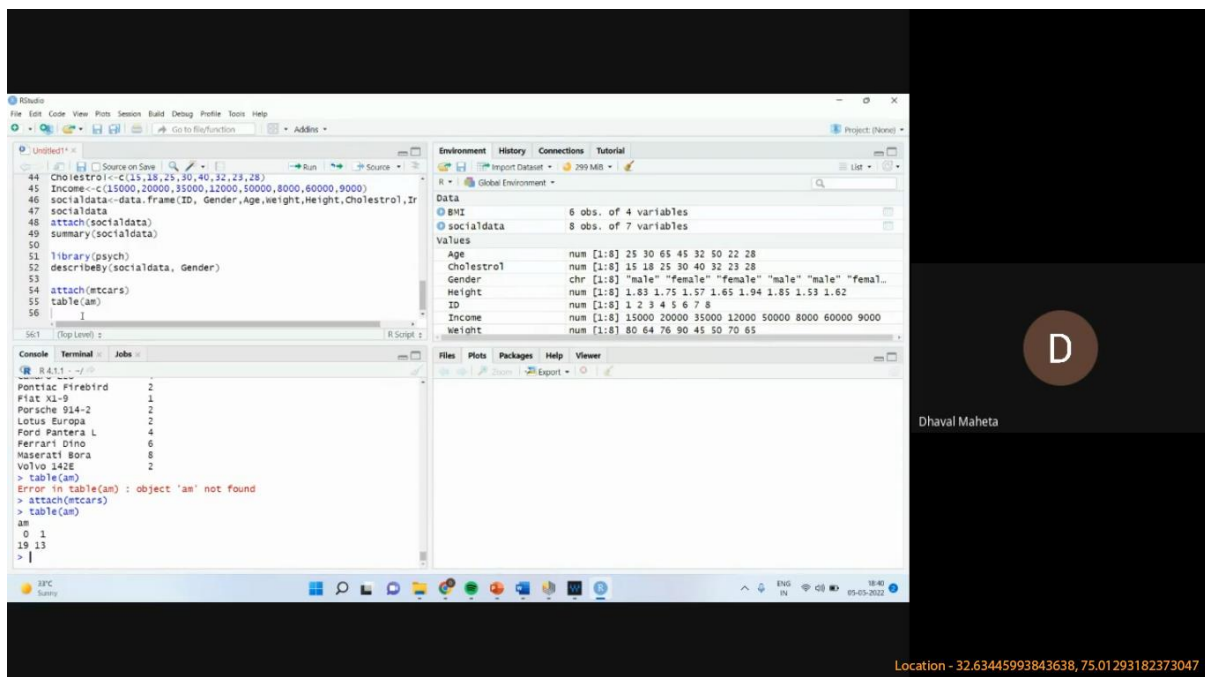
Day-1 (2nd May, 2022) Inaugural Session:

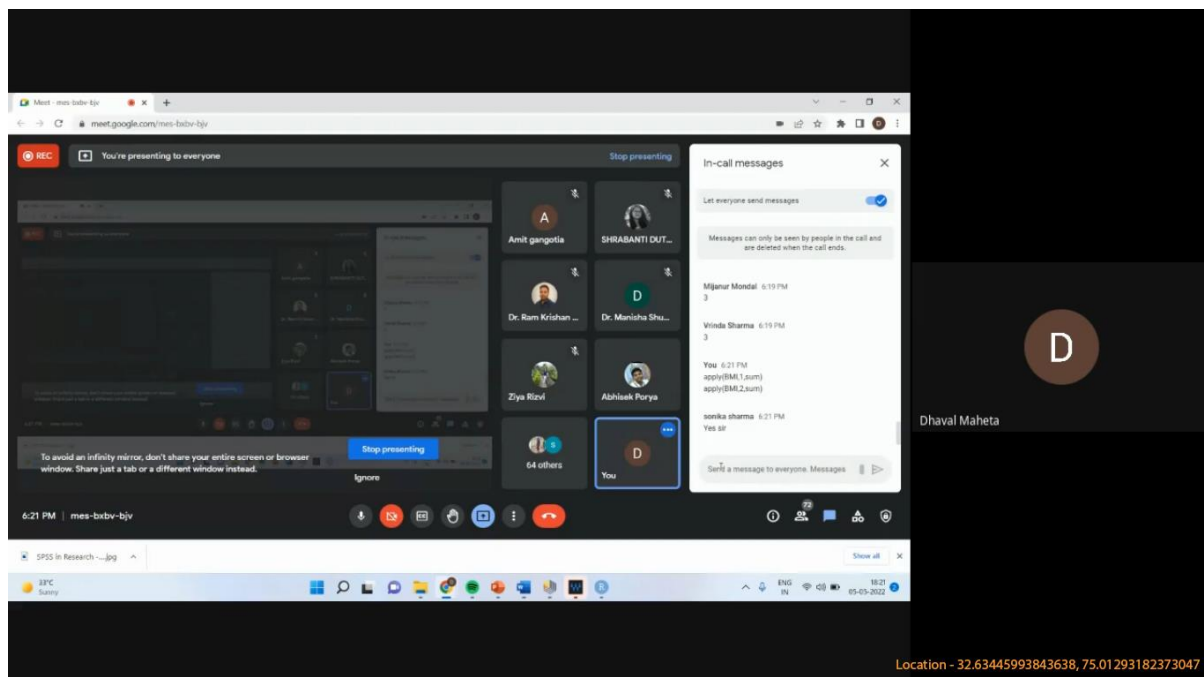


Day-2 (3rd May, 2022)

Day-3 (4th May, 2022)

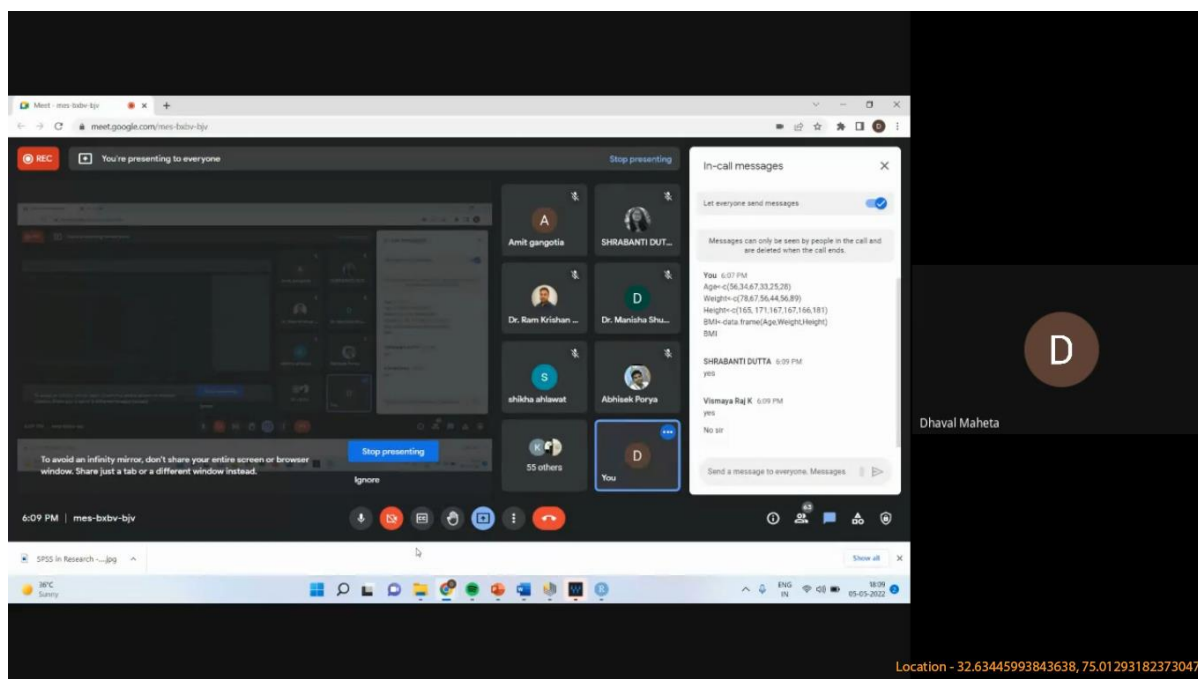
