Introductory

2. The Vice Chancellor extended a very warm welcome to all the members of the newly constituted 3rd Academic Council of the Central University of Jammu. He also welcomed Prof. Javed Musarrat, Vice Chancellor, BGSU, Rajouri, who attended the Academic Council meeting for the first time. The worthy members of the council introduced themselves.



3. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members about the various developmental initiatives undertaken by the University during the period through a detailed power point presentation. He informed that 45 programs have been offered during the current Academic session. He also informed that UGC has recently sanctioned 03 new Departments i.e. Department of Law, Department of Visual & Performing Arts and Department of Tourism Management along with 21 teaching positions (1 Professor, 02 Associate Professor and 04 Assistant Professor in each Department). He informed that a case has been taken up to sanction (as projected by Central University of Jammu) Dept. of Earth Sciences in place of Dept. of Tourism Management as the Dept. of Tourism and Travel Management already exists in the Central University of Jammu.

4. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members about the various meetings of the University Court, Executive Council, Finance Committee, School Board, Board of Studies, Planning Board, Board of Research Studies, Building Committee held in the university after the last meeting of the Academic Council.

5. The Vice Chancellor informed the members about the pass percentage of UG, PG and Integrated programs for the Academic Session 2018-19, of which the examinations were held in December, 2018.

6. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members about the promotion of faculty members under Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) from Assistant Professor Stage-I to Assistant Professor Stage-II. The faculty benefited under CAS are:

7. The Vice Chancellor presented the details of various workshops/seminars/events/lectures held in the university. Some of the events are as follows:

- a. Directorate of Internal Quality Assurance (DIQA), University of Jammu in collaboration with Central University of Jammu organised a day long National Assessment Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore sponsored workshop on **"NAAC Accreditation and Assessment Awareness" on 27th August 2018.**
- b. On 6th September, 2018, a three day National Conference on **"Destination Branding and Competitive Positioning"** was organized by the School of Business Studies, Central University of Jammu sponsored by Ministry of Tourism, Gol.
- c. From 14th to 28th September, 2018, Central University of Jammu organized **'Induction Programme'** for newly appointed non-teaching employees of Central University of Jammu.
- d. Central University of Jammu celebrated **Hindi Pakhwara** from 14th to 28th September, 2018.
- e. 1st Convention was organised by The STRATFIRST INDIA In collaboration with DIQA, Central University of Jammu and University of Jammu on the theme **"Global Ranking in Higher Education: Issues and Challenges"** on 27th September, 2018.
- f. On 11th October, 2018, a two day National workshop on **"Imagining- The future of the Space Science and its strategic importance"** was organized by Department of Physics and Astronomical Sciences, Central University of Jammu at its main campus Bagla which was sponsored by Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO), Department of Space, Govt. of India



- g. On 20th October, 2018, Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu and IGP, Jammu, flagged off coaches from J&K (Jammu Segment) for a week long workshop on **Leadership through Sports Program** for Jammu & Kashmir at Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi. The programme was jointly organized by Central University of Jammu and Ball State University, Indiana, USA under US Indian Public Diplomacy Grants, USA. In all 20 coaches from J&K (Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh) attended the program at Delhi.
- h. A two day workshop on the topic **“Teacher as Resource, ICT and MOOCs for Quality in Teaching Learning”** was organized at DIET Leh by Centre for Learning and Pedagogics, Centre for Teacher Resource and Academic Support and Centre for Assessment and Evaluation, School of Education, Central University of Jammu, under the aegis of Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching on 13th November, 2018
- i. Department of Botany, Central University of Jammu organized a two day National Conference on the topic **“Recent Development in Plant Stress Biology: Translating Laboratory Research to Human Welfare (RDPSB2019; 7-8 Dec,18)”** at Brig. Rajinder Singh Auditorium, University of Jammu.
- j. Department of Computer Science and Information Technology, Central University of Jammu, in collaboration with C-DAC Mohali organised one week workshop from December 10th -14th, 2018 on the topic **“e-Suruksa”** under the aegis of the project on Information Security Education and Awareness (ISEA), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Govt. of India.
- k. The Department of National Security Studies, Central University of Jammu, organized a National Seminar on the topic **“Trans-boundary Issues in South Asia” specially focusing on Indus Water Treaty and Indo-Pak Relations** at the auditorium, School of Business Studies, University of Jammu on 09th February, 2019. The key speakers on this occasion were Shri Pradeep Kumar Saxena, Indian Commissioner for Indus Water Treaty, Gol; Shri Balraj Joshi, Chairman and Managing Director, NHPC; Amb. (Retd.) G. Parthasarathy, Chancellor, Central University of Jammu; Amb. (Retd.) Phunchok Stobdan, President, Ladakh International Centre, Leh; Lt. Gen. Syed Ata Hasnain (Retd.), Chancellor, Central University of Kashmir; Shri Tilak Devasher, Former Special Secretary, Cabinet Secretariat and Prof. Amitabh Mattoo, School of International Studies, JNU.



- I. The School of Education, Central University of Jammu, organized four days '**Vice Chancellors**' meet under the title "**Academic Leadership Training in Higher Education**" from 12th February, 2019 to 15th February, 2019, at Brig. Rajinder Singh Auditorium, CUJ. The event was organized under the aegis of Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Training (PMMMNTT) in collaboration with Association of Indian Universities (AIU). About 30 Vice Chancellors/ Directors/Heads & Deans of different Institutions participated in this four days Vice Chancellors meet.
8. The Vice-Chancellor apprised the house that the University has signed MoUs with different institutions / organisations for the exchange of resources, research in new emerging areas, creation of infrastructural facilities in the university. The details of MoUs signed are as follows:
- a. An MoU was signed between Central Scientific Instruments Organisation (CSIR- CSIO), Chandigarh and Central University of Jammu, Jammu on Oct. 11, 2018 to start the sharing of instrumentation facilities and collaborative research in materials science, sensor, biomedical and computational etc. MoU was signed by Dr H. K. Sardana, Officiating Director and Chief Scientist, CSIR- CSIO, Chandigarh and Dr. Ravi Kumar, Registrar, Central University of Jammu in presence of Dr. Jitendra Singh, Union Minister, Govt of India, Dr. K. Sivan, ISRO, Chairman, Prof. Ashok Aima, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Jammu, Dr. Radhakrishnan, Ex- ISRO Chairman during National Workshop on "Imagining the future of the space Science and its strategic importance" organized by Department of Physics and Astronomical Sciences, Central University of Jammu.
 - b. The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) signed an MoU with the Central University of Jammu (CUJ) in Jammu on Oct 11, 2018 for setting up of the "Satish Dhawan Centre for Space Science" in the University. The MoU was signed in the presence of Hon'ble Union Minister, Govt of India, Dr. Jitendra Singh, ISRO Chairman- Dr. K Sivan, Former Chairman ISRO & Member of Executive Council, Central University of Jammu- Dr. K Radhakrishnan and CEO & Chairman J & K Bank- Jenab Parvez Ahmed.
 - c. On 28th December, 2018, Central University of Jammu, signed MoU with J&K Bank to establish a state-of-the-art Business Unit with the digital lobby at its main campus, Bagla. The Business Unit will have digital



banking and infotainment facilities for university students, scholars and the faculty, creation of facilities like Student Information Centre, Pride Corner, Outdoor and Indoor Amphitheatre, Mini Café, Seminar Room, Book Wall and Digital Banking Lobby.

- d. Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Central University of Jammu will sign an MoU for establishment of DRDO centre in the University. In this regard Team of DRDO officials visited the University on Jan 15-16, 2019 wherein it was resolved to establish two verticals namely Computational Systems Security and Sensors. High performance computing facility in the University with 20-25 GPU Grade Server along with high speed networking infrastructure would be established to enable the research work under this vertical. DRDO will support budget for Consultancy, Logistic support, SRF, JRF, Training, Workshops, Conferences, Collaboration with other Academic Institutes etc. Five acres of land was identified for setting up the buildings and supporting infrastructure of the DRDO.
- e. An MoU was signed between Indian Council of World Affairs, New Delhi and Central University of Jammu on 09 Feb 2019 to facilitate seamless movement and exchange of students, scholars and the faculty for an informed and rational view and interpretations of world affairs.

9. The Vice Chancellor informed the house that Prof. Sei-Chiro Ueki, Tokai University of Japan, visited Department of Mathematics, Central University of Jammu on 5th October, 2018. The main purpose of this visit was to strengthen the research ties between two universities. Prof. Ueki, has already established a collaborative research link with Dr. Ajay K. Sharma, Head, Department of Mathematics, Central University of Jammu and they have jointly published 05 research papers in leading international journals.

10. The Vice Chancellor was delighted to inform the members that Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Regional Directorate of NSS, Govt. of India, New Delhi, has empanelled Central University of Jammu for Jammu Division as Empanelled Training Institute (ETI) for training of Programme Officers under ETI. An MoU was also signed between the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports,



Regional Directorate of NSS, Govt. of India, New Delhi and Central University of Jammu.

11. The Vice Chancellor informed the house that in order to promote sports excellence and to formulate a long term sports policy, the first **Sports Advisory Council** meeting was held on 16th January, 2019 at CUJ, Main Campus. A council constituting of top sports achievers and experts of International Standing from the state comprised Shri Ranjeet Kalra, Co-Chairman of the Council & Advisor for Sports, Govt. of Lakshdweep; Shri Haji Abdul Qayoom, Chief Sports Officer, J&K State Sports Council; Shri Ashok Kumar, Director Sports, Shrine Board, Katra; Shri S.P. Singh, Senior Officer J&K State Sports Council and other senior sports members of J&K State attended the meeting.

12. The Vice Chancellor apprised the members that a two day book exhibition was held at CUJ, Main Campus Bagla, on 13th and 14th November, 2018. About 23 book-sellers and publishers across the country have displayed their books in the exhibition.
