

Constitution Day organized at Jammu Central University: Teachers, staff, researchers and students read the Preamble



On the occasion of Samvidhan Diwas (Constitution Day) the Office of the Dean Students' Welfare, CU Jammu, organised a "Preamble" reading ceremony at University campus; to commemorate the day of adoption of our Indian constitution.
